# MUSICXML IMPORT



- Import MusicXML files into your template
  - Retain the staff size, text styles and other unique “look” you need
  - A simple way to create accessible versions of music
  - Import only the staves you need e.g. vocal line without the other instruments
1. Open your template that has your House Style (look you want to achieve)
  2. Go to File > Import and choose your Music XML file
  3. Import the staves you need
